

Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central or 365 for Finance & Operations?

Which is the right Microsoft Dynamics ERP system for your business?

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Introduction

These days, no mid-sized manufacturing business can seriously contemplate operating without a modern ERP system. And not just any ERP system. Growing—and growing profitably—is almost impossible without a system that is appropriate for the business's needs, and which possesses the right mix of industry-specific and business-specific features and functionality.

And in the search for such a system, the logic behind taking a close look at a Microsoft ERP system is clear enough.

Microsoft, after all, is not only a significant player in the ERP marketplace, but also possesses an extensive set of enterprise software offerings stretching across CRM, Business Intelligence and desktop productivity applications. Many of which, of course, are fine-tuned to integrate closely with Microsoft's core ERP offerings.

At which point, though, things get a little more complicated.

Which Microsoft ERP system should you look at? **Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations**, or **Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central**? Both are widely used, with broad appeal to most mid-sized businesses.

By the way, if the name Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations is new to you, it's the latest iteration in the evolution of Microsoft's former flagship ERP system, Microsoft Dynamics AX. Likewise, if the name Dynamics 365 Business Central is new to you, this is the latest development of the most widely used Microsoft ERP product, Dynamics NAV.

Frankly—and this may surprise you—the bottom line is that for many manufacturing businesses in the £10-£100 million revenue range, either ERP system would be a decent fit. Granted, one might be a better fit than the other, but either would do the job.

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Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations is the evolution of Microsoft's former flagship ERP system, Dynamics AX.

Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central, meanwhile, is the latest development of Dynamics Microsoft NAV.





Which is best for my business?

There's no cookie-cutter kind of answer to the 'which Dynamics 365 ERP system is best for our business?' question.

It's best to seek advice from someone who genuinely understands, sells and supports both systems.

Introduction

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Put another way, there's no 'one size fits all', cookie-cutter kind of answer to the 'Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations, or Dynamics 365 Business Central?' question. Both are frequently sensible choices, and it's usually necessary to drill into the fine detail in order to determine which is truly the best fit for a given business.

Which, simply put, can be a problem. Because many sources of advice have a vested interest in opting for one system or the other. They sell and support Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations. Or they sell and support Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central. But remarkably few Microsoft ERP implementation specialists genuinely sell and support both, and possess genuine expertise in both.

At eBECS, their Microsoft ERP experts are different. They do genuinely sell, support, and advise on both.

So to help you determine which is the right Microsoft ERP system for your business, I spent some time with them exploring the key factors to consider when deciding between Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations and Dynamics 365 Business Central.

Like Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations, Dynamics 365 Business Central works with the familiar Microsoft tools you use already, and you get the same powerful capabilities across iOS, Android and Windows platforms.



The take-away here is clearcut: Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central is a good fit for decentralised global operations, while Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations has the edge when it comes to handling more centralised global operations.

For some manufacturing companies, the additional manufacturing and traceability features of Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations will be 'must haves', for compliance or operational reasons.

Other manufacturers, once they have sat down with an implementer such as eBECS and compared their requirements with what Dynamics 365 Business Central has to offer, will find they are amply catered for by Business Central's extensive manufacturing feature set. Company Structure

Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central

Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central offers multi company, multilingual and inter company transaction capabilities, together with localisations.

Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance & Operations

Just like Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central, Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations offers multi company, multilingual, intercompany and localisation features.

However, it also permits a single database to contain multiple companies and multiple localisations.

Manufacturing Mode

Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central

Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central offers a rich set of manufacturing capabilities.

In terms of traceability, Dynamics 365 Business Central provides serial number and lot number tracking.

Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance & Operations

Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations similarly offers a rich set of manufacturing capabilities, but also contains additional functionality that gives it the edge in process manufacturing and lean manufacturing environments. It's also likely to be the better solution if your business has extensive engineer-to-order and configure-to-order processes.

Traceability is another differentiator: while Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central provides serial number and lot number tracking, Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations adds to this with pallet number and so-called 'licence plate' tracking functionality. Unless your business operates in regions of the world where Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations' 'mixed-mode' capability is useful, there isn't a great deal of difference between Dynamics 365 Business Central and Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations in terms of deployment options.

Subtle small deployment differences may be significant to individual businesses, but these are best explored with one of eBECS' Dynamics ERP experts.

In general, licensing is broadly comparable across Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations and Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central.

The exception: Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations' device-level licensing options, which don't require the purchase of an additional ISV solution. Key factors to consider when deciding between Dynamics 365 Business Central and Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations

Deployment Choices

Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central

Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central can be deployed on premise and in the Cloud on Microsoft Azure, for instance, or on the eBECS Private Cloud. Indeed, eBECS offers its Cloud based DaaS (Dynamics as a Service) for Dynamics 365 Business Central.

Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance & Operations

Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations can likewise be hosted onpremise, or in the Cloud.

There's also a 'mixed-mode' capability, enabling businesses to operate Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations in the Cloud in locations where Internet connectivity is good, and on-premise where that isn't the case.

Licensing Costs

Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central

Licences for Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central can be bought on either named user perpetual basis, or on a subscription basis for named users.

Device licences—for handhelds and shopfloor data capture, for instance are also available, but only via an associated ISV solution.

Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance & Operations

Licences for Cloud-based Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations deployments are on a named user subscriptions basis, or device-level subscriptions that can be used by multiple users. Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations is a more complex and capable offering, and if your business intends to make use of those capabilities, configuration and deployment will cost slightly more.

But it's often surprising how the use of standard templates and processes can reduce these costs—so talk to an eBECS expert.

Key factors to consider when deciding between Dynamics 365 Business Central and Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations

Configuration and Deployment Services Costs

Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central

Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central typically has a 1:2 license-toservice cost ratio.

In other words, every £1k of licence will typically require £2k of associated configuration and deployment services.

Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance & Operations

With Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations, the comparable licence-to-service cost ratio is typically 1:4.

As with Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central, a template-based 'best practice' deployment, using the standard business processes and standard configuration options available through Microsoft's 'lifecycle services', and eBECS' own implementation process and rapid return methodologies, can reduce costs and timescales.



Conclusion

Dynamics 365 Business Central or Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations?

How best then to sum up the choice between Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations, and Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central?

With each solution providing a reasonable fit for most businesses, it's necessary to probe into the fine detail in order to determine which is the best fit for you.

In short, it all depends on a business's individual requirements and circumstances: there are no simple, 'one size fits all' answers.

The most valuable piece of advice is this: talking to people who know both solutions very well indeed—and who can provide objective advice on both solutions—is vital. And at eBECS, you'll find those people.
